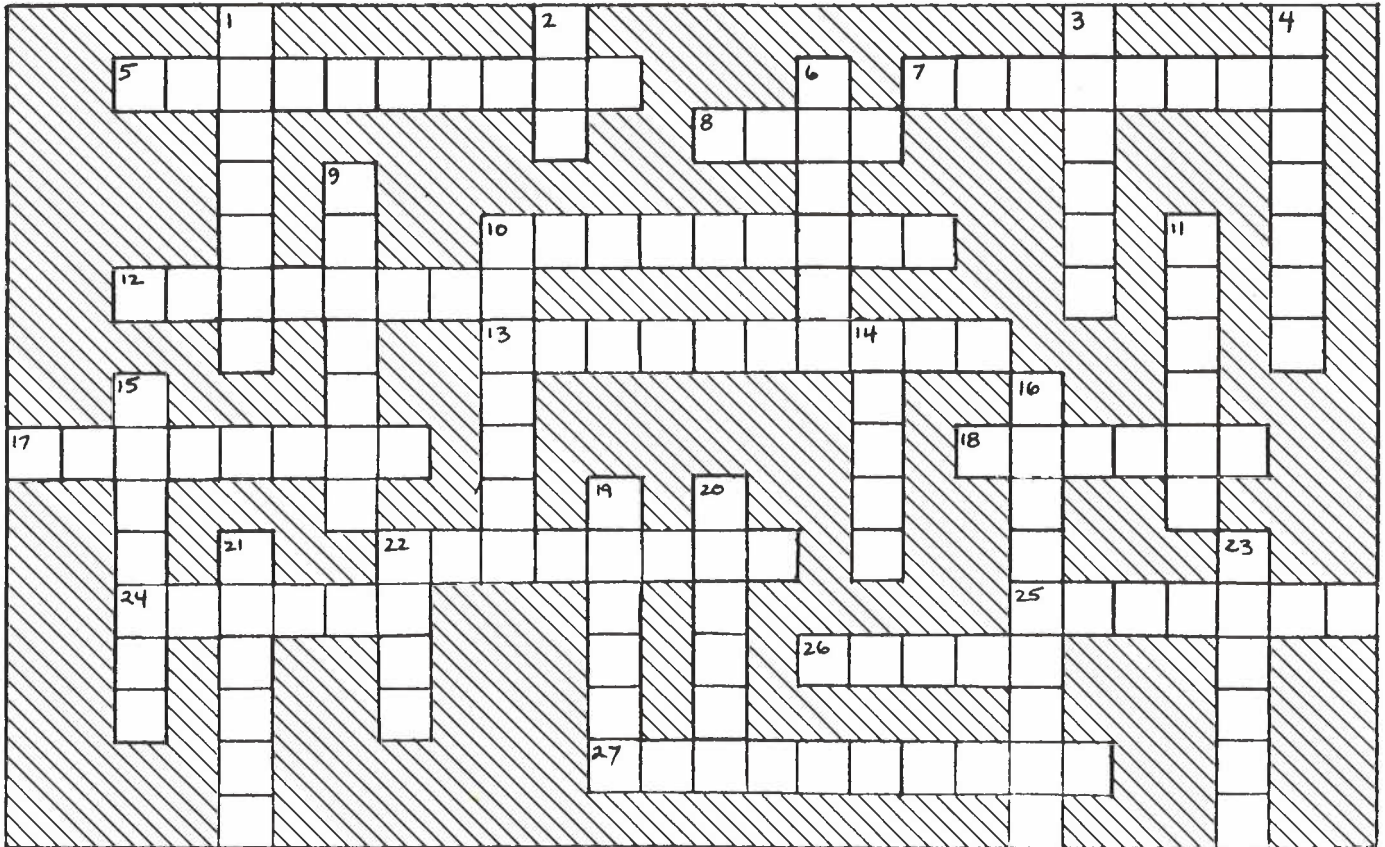


# PLACE NAMES PUZZLE
